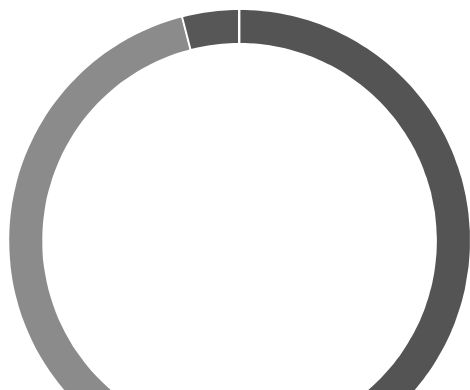

Procter & Gamble Co. engages in the provision of branded consumer packaged goods. It operates through the following segments: Beauty, Grooming, Health Care, Fabric and Home Care, and Baby, Feminine and Family Care. The Beauty segment offers hair, skin, and personal care. The Grooming segment consists of shave care like female and male blades and razors, pre and post shave products, and appliances. The Health Care segment includes oral care products like toothbrushes, toothpaste, and personal health care such as gastrointestinal, rapid diagnostics, respiratory, and vitamins, minerals, and supplements. The Fabric and Home care segment consists of fabric enhancers, laundry additives and detergents, and air, dish, and surface care. The Baby, Feminine and Family Care segment sells baby wipes, diapers, and pants, adult incontinence, feminine care, paper towels, tissues, and toilet paper. The company was founded by William Procter and James Gamble in 1837 and is headquartered in Cincinnati, OH.

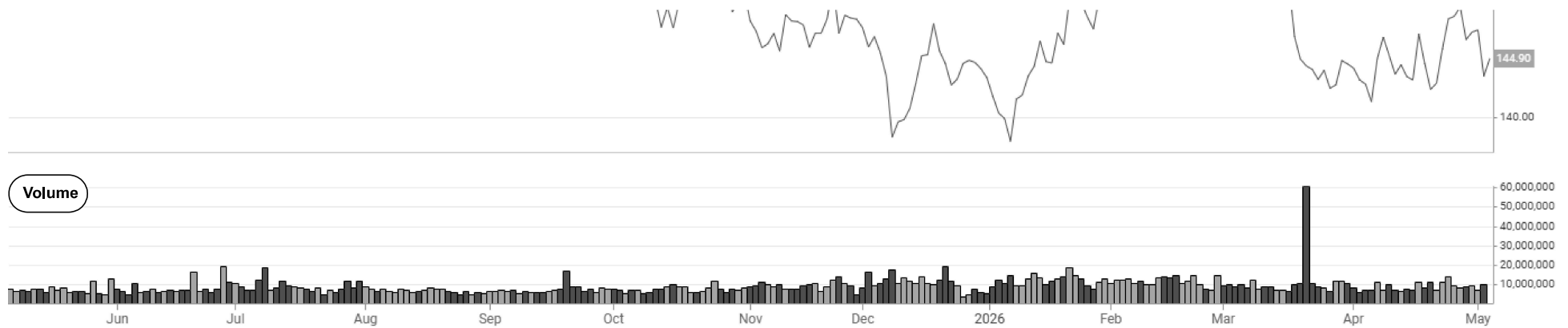

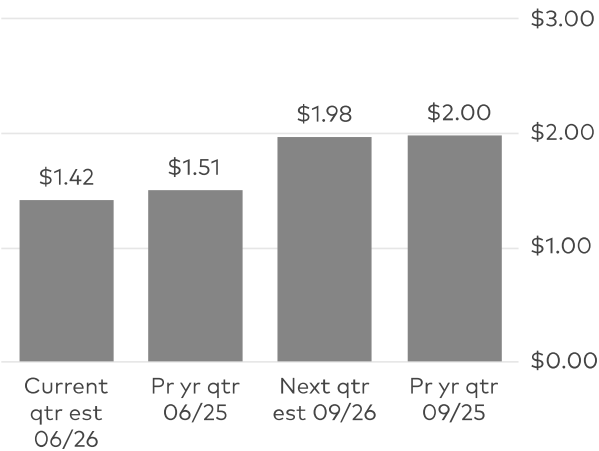

Investment thesis

Recent relative weakness provides buying opportunityThe PG shares have underperformed the S&P over the past quarter, rising 1% compared to gains of 2% for the S&P 500 and 1% for the Consumer Goods industry ETF IYK.Procter & Gamble recently reported fiscal 3Q26 earnings that beat the consensus estimate.The company has a long history of dividends and management has shown confidence with the most recent 3% increase in the dividend, which now yields about 2.9%.Our target price of \$180 implies a multiple of 25-times our FY27 EPS estimate.

Investment thesis

MarketGrader currently rates Procter & Gamble Company HOLD, based on an overall grade of 54.30 (out of 100). This grade is calculated as the sum of our 24 fundamental indicators across Growth, Value, Profitability and Cash Flow and reflects our view on the investment merit of the stock in the next 18 months. Our methodology, which focuses on identifying growth-at-a-reasonable-price oportunities among public equities requires a minimum overall grade of 60 in order to issue a BUY rating; in this case, the company's fundamentals are average at best and not deserving of a better rating without an improvement in the company's

performance, a more attractive valuation, or a combination of both. We have maintained this rating since July 18, 2025, when we upgraded the stock from SELL, based on an overall grade of 49.81. Since then, the stock is down 4.46%.
